

Wapuu Amigurumi Pattern By Totally Hooked Toys

Materials needed:

- Crochet needle 2mm
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle
- Yellow yarn
- Orange yarn
- Blue yarn
- 4 mm black safety eyes
- Polyester soft toy stuffing
- Pipe cleaner wire for the tale (optional)
- WordPress pin

Stitches abbreviations:

Ch: chain
Sc: single crochet
Hdc: half double crochet
Inc: increase
Dec: decrease
Blo: back loops only
Flo: front loops only
Sl st: slip stitch

Note:

Crochet in a spiral, unless the pattern specifies to use a different method and always mark the beginning of a new row to keep track of your work. Have fun crocheting! :)

Ball

Use blue yarn

Rnd 1: 8 sc into a magic ring	(8 sc)
Rnd 2: work 2 sc in each sc around	(16 sc)
Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc 1 * around	(24 sc)
Rnd 4: 3 sc, inc 1 * around	(30 sc)
Rnd 5 - 7: 1 sc in each sc	(30 sc)
Rnd 8: 3 sc, dec 1 * around	(24 sc)
Rnd 9: 1 sc, dec 1 * around	(16 sc)
Rnd 10: dec 8 times	(8sc)

Close hole by sewing with tapestry needle in flo and pulling together.

Body

Use yellow yarn

Rnd 1: 6 sc into a magic ring	(6 sc)
Rnd 2: work 2 sc in each sc around	(12 sc)
Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc 1 * around	(18 sc)
Rnd 4: 3 sc, inc 3, 6 sc, inc 3, 3 sc	(24 sc)
Rnd 5 - 7: 1 sc in each sc	(24 sc)
Rnd 8: 9 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 10 sc	(22 sc)
Rnd 9: 9 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 10 sc	(24 sc)

Put the safety eyes on now. Fit them between rounds 5 and 6 leaving about 1 cm (3 stitches) between them.

You can also work on the face now for easier access. Make the nose and mouth I placed them on rounds 7 and 8, however every toy is different so do what you can to make the cutest face possible. :) After you're done making the face stuff the head and keep stuffing while you're working.

NB! *Stuff the middle part of the body very lightly.*

Rnd 10 - 17: 1 sc in each sc	(24 sc)
Rnd 18: 3 sc, dec 3 times, 6 sc, dec 3 times, 3 sc	(18 sc)
Rnd 19: 1 sc, 1 dec* around	(12 sc)
Rnd 20: dec 6 times	(6 sc)

Close hole by sewing with tapestry needle in flo and pulling together.

Ears (make 2)

Use orange yarn

*Do not crochet in spiral, follow along the chain.

Chain 5.

Make a slip stitch in the 2nd chain from hook; 1 sc inc; 1 hdc; 1 hdc, chain 2 and make another hdc in the same sc; turn and start working on the back of the chain; 1 hdc; 1 sc; sl st.

Sew on row 3 of the body.

Hands (make 2)

Use yellow yarn

Rnd 1: 5 sc in a magic circle	(5 sc)
Rnd 2 - 4: 1 sc in each sc	(5 sc)
Rnd 5: 2 sc, inc, 2 sc	(6sc)
Rnd 6 -7: 1 sc in each sc	(6sc)
Rnd 8: 3 sc, inc, 2 sc	(7 sc)

Stuff hands and sew to body on rounds 10-12. Sew ball, body and hands together.

Legs (make 2)

Use yellow yarn

*Do not crochet in spiral for the 1st round, follow along the chain. Make sure to still mark the beginning of a new round.

Chain 5. Sc in 2nd chain from hook; 1sc in next 2 sc; inc next sc, turn and work 1 more sc in the same sc; sc in next 3 sc. (9 sc)

Rnd 2: 1sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc	(12 sc)
Rnd 3: in blo: 2 dec; in all loops: 6 sc; in blo: 1 dec	(9 sc)
Rnd 4: 2 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec	(6 sc)
Rnd 5: 1 sc in each sc	(6 sc)
<i>Start stuffing the leg</i>	
Rnd 6: 3 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc	(10 sc)
Rnd 7: 1 sc in each sc	(10 sc)
Rnd 8: 4 inc, 6 sc	(14 sc)
Rnd 9 - 10: 1 sc in each sc	(14 sc)
Rnd 11: 3 sc, 4 dec, 3 sc	(10 sc)
Rnd 12: 1 sc, 4 dec, 1 sc	(6 sc)

Stuff the rest of the leg and close off. Sew legs on body.

Tail

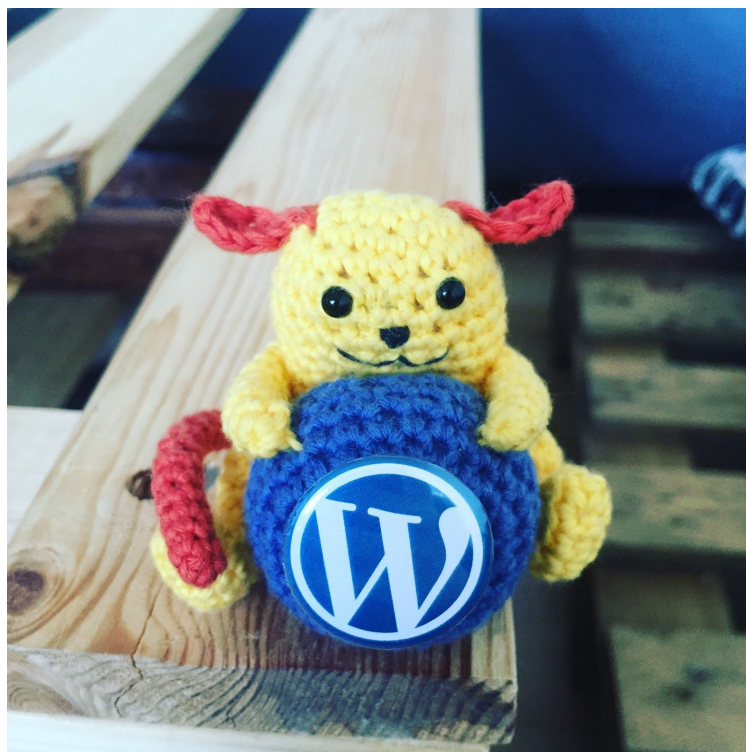
Use orange yarn

Rnd 1: 4 sc in magic ring	(4 sc)
Rnd 2 - 5: 1 sc in each sc	(4 sc)
Rnd 6: 1 inc, 3 sc	(5 sc)
Rnd 7- 18: 1 sc in each sc	(5 sc)
Rnd 19: 1 inc, 4 sc	(6 sc)
Rnd 20 - 22: 1 sc in each sc	(6 sc)

Put wire in the tail and sew to body.

Finally

Place your WordPress pin in the middle of the ball.
